

Before Starting the Project Listings for the CoC Priority Listing

The FY 2017 CoC Consolidated Application requires TWO submissions. Both this Project Priority Listing AND the CoC Application MUST be submitted prior to the CoC Program Competition deadline as required by the FY 2017 CoC Program Competition NOFA.

The FY 2017 CoC Priority Listing includes the following:

- Reallocation forms – must be fully completed if the CoC is reallocating eligible renewal projects to create new projects as described in the FY 2017 CoC Program Competition NOFA.
- New Project Listing – lists all new project applications created through reallocation and the permanent housing bonus that have been approved and ranked or rejected by the CoC.
- Renewal Project Listing – lists all eligible renewal project applications that have been approved and ranked or rejected by the CoC.
- UFA Costs Project Listing – applicable and only visible for Collaborative Applicants that were designated as a Unified Funding Agency (UFA) during the FY 2017 CoC Program Registration process. Only 1 UFA Costs project application is permitted and can only be submitted by the Collaborative Applicant.
- CoC Planning Project Listing – Only 1 CoC planning project is permitted per CoC and can only be submitted by the Collaborative Applicant.

Things to Remember:

3-2. Describe how the CoC determined that this project should be eliminated and include the date the project applicant was notified. (limit 750 characters)

At its August 1, 2017 Governing Board meeting, the CoC announced its intention to reallocate this program and on September 1, notified the Board of its intention of moving forward with this plan. The Ralph Moses House is a facility based- TH project dedicated to homeless men living with AIDS. The needs of the CoC have changed since this program was designed 20 years ago, it no longer maintains full occupancy, does not meet the most pressing needs in the CoC and is in jeopardy of losing other funding with the modernization of the HOPWA formula. Reallocation funds will be used to create a Joint TH-RRH program that uses this site plus 10 RA units to meet the needs of vulnerable homeless adults with high needs. The CoC sent the grantee an email on September 5 confirming this decision.

At its August 1, 2017 Governing Board meeting, the CoC announced its intention to reallocate this program and on September 1, notified the Board of its intention of moving forward with this plan. This project has consistently underspent and does not fully adhere to the principles of Housing First. The funds will be used for the new Joint TH-RRH project. The CoC sent the grantee an email on September 5 confirming this decision.

The CoC Governing Board determined that under spending and Housing First compliance were the 2 most important factors in determining grant reductions and reallocation. On Sept. 5, 2017, the Delaware County Housing Authority was notified via email that this project was being reduced. The notice included the Governing Board reasons for the reduction due to under spending. Although the project exceeded the projected number of persons to be served, there was under-spending reported each of the past 3 years. Housing First compliance was also identified as a barrier to housing people quickly.






