

Non-Discrimination Policy

Delaware County Children and Youth Services does not exclude, deny benefits to, or otherwise discriminate against any person on the ground of race, color, national origin, disability, age, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, religion or creed in admission to, participation in, or receipt of the services and benefits under any of its programs and activities, whether carried out by Delaware County Children and Youth Services directly or through a contractor or any other entity with which Delaware County Children and Youth Services arranges to carry out its programs and activities.

Any person who believes someone has been subjected to discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability may file a grievance under this procedure. It is against the law for Delaware County Children and Youth Services to retaliate against anyone who opposes discrimination, files a grievance, or participates in the investigation of a grievance.
